

Onward Israel Program - Entry & Quarantine Requirements

- Please note the information outlined below is only applicable for programs that are considered non-masa programs.
- For any vaccination to be counted as valid, the vaccination must have been administered at least 7 days prior to the program start date.
- All vaccinations **MUST** be FDA approved otherwise they fall under the category of “non-vaccinated”.
- All participants must carry out a PCR test within 72 hours before their departure flight to Israel.

Recovered	Recovered from illness <u>within 1 year</u> of program start date PLUS at least 1 vaccination dose administered <u>within 6 months</u> of program start date	PCR test upon arrival Serological test upon arrival Quarantine upon arrival until receiving negative PCR test result
	Recovered from illness <u>within 1 year</u> of program start date PLUS at least 1 vaccination dose administered <u>more than 6 months</u> of program start.	PCR test upon arrival Serological test upon arrival Minimum 7 day quarantine upon arrival PCR test on day 7 Released from quarantine after receiving negative PCR test result from day 7 test
Unvaccinated	Unvaccinated (Note: for the purposes of this document, any status <u>not</u> outlined above is considered unvaccinated.)	Currently not allowed to enter Israel
