



Onward Israel Entry & Quarantine Requirements – FOR MASA PROGRAMS

- Please note the information outlined below is only applicable for programs that are considered Onward Israel Masa programs.
- Vaccinations MUST be one of the following recognized and accepted vaccinations in Israel: Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Sinovac, Sinopharm, Johnson and Johnson, Serum Institute of India, and Sputnik (only as of December 1, 2021)*.
- For any vaccination to be counted as valid, the vaccination must have been administered at least 14 days prior to the program start date.
- Participants will be asked to provide official state vaccination certificates including dates and/or recovery documentation which shows a positive PCR test result obtained from a certified laboratory to both the airline and border control upon arrival in Israel.
- Participants must NOT have visited a red country within 14 days of arrival to Israel otherwise entry to Israel will be denied. Check here to see if a country is on the [red list](#).
- All participants must carry out a PCR test within 72 hours before their departure flight to Israel.
- 24 hours before departure to Israel, participants will need to complete an [Entry Statement Form](#) which will include uploading all the relevant documents requested i.e vaccination certificate.
- Participants who hold Israeli citizenship may be subject to different entry & quarantine requirements. Participants should contact their program organizer for more clarification.

Recovered	Recovered from illness <u>within 180 days</u> of program end date PLUS at least 1 vaccination dose AND holds an EU Digital Recovery Certificate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Entry Permit required. Participants can enter under a tourist visa (see Ministry of Health regulations for more info) • PCR test upon arrival • Quarantine upon arrival until receiving negative PCR test result • Green Pass may be issued
Unvaccinated	Unvaccinated* (Note: for the purposes of this document, any status <u>not</u> outlined above is considered unvaccinated.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently not allowed to enter Israel <p>*In certain cases, whereby a participant is unable to get a vaccination in their country of residence, exceptions <u>may</u> be made. Participants should speak directly with their program organizer about this.</p>

*In cases of Sputnik vaccination, participants will be required to undergo a serological test upon arrival at the airport and are required to stay in isolation until testing positive on a serologic test and negative on the PCR test taken immediately after arrival. If a negative result on a PCR test is not obtained, and 24 hours from the time of arrival in Israel pass, isolation continues until receiving a positive test result on the serologic test. If the serologic test result is negative, the participant will have to go back to the country of origin.

** Onward Israel Program Organizers will arrange vaccination boosters for participants but in some cases this is not always possible. In cases where the program organizer is unable to arrange vaccination boosters, entry permits cannot be issued and participants will be unable to enter Israel.
